Madison Spiritualist Camp Meeting Association Inc
(Established 1879)

Originally the summer meeting place of the local Native Americans through the 1600's, the area was later settled by the Jedediah Hayden family in the early 1800's. One of the Hayden family heirs, William D. Hayden, set aside some land for the Madison Spiritualist Association in 1879 at Hayden's Grove on the west side of Hayden's Pond (as the lake was then called).

The first two years the meetings were held outdoors until a building was constructed in 1882, which is now the Lakewood Summer Theater. Then in 1895, William D. Hayden bought the building with a condition of sale guaranteeing that the Spiritualists would always have a place to meet on the campgrounds.

As a result, we now own and meet in a small chapel on the grounds. We are in Lakewood Village six miles North of Skowhegan on Route 201, on the West side of Lake Wesserunsett, as it is now called. Being surrounded by the good feelings of all the ancestors, pioneers and people who come to the camp- grounds each summer gives the area a strong spiritual attraction and leaves us with a special place to celebrate Spiritualism each summer.

We welcome everyone and invite those of other faiths to investigate the phenomena and teachings of Spiritualism.
